*It's summertime so get em out of the garage.*

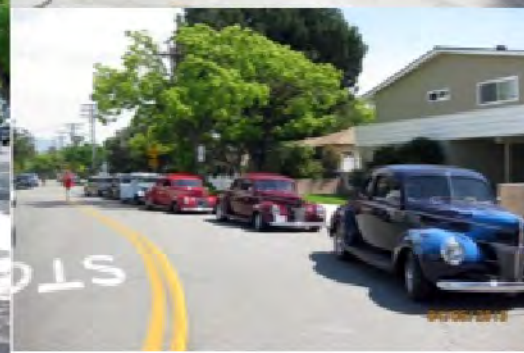

## AL WHITE'S RACING REPORT



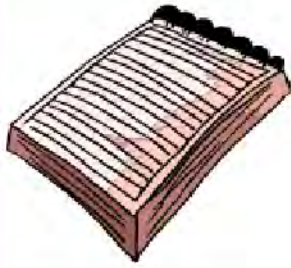
